

How Do I Vote?

To vote in the Arvada Fire Protection District election, you must be a registered voter in the State of Colorado and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 1) live in the District
- 2) personally own property in the District
- 3) be the spouse or civil union partner of the owner of property in the District.

If you are registered to vote in Colorado and meet at least one of the requirements above, please complete and submit the [Application for Permanent Absentee Voter Status](#).

Note: Your name will remain on the Permanent Absentee Voter list unless you move or request to be removed.

If you are not registered to vote in Colorado or if your address has changed since the last Arvada Fire election and you have not updated it with the Secretary of State or when updating your driver's license, you must do so before requesting an absentee voter ballot. If your name was previously on the list of permanent absentee voters, you will not automatically receive an absentee ballot. You must complete another [Application for Permanent Absentee Voter Status](#).
