Greer Named Fire Chief

ARVADA – At their April 25, 2007 meeting, the Arvada Fire Protection District’s Board of Directors promoted Deputy Chief Jon Greer to Fire Chief effective immediately. Greer has been the interim Fire Chief since Paul Dextras resigned as Chief on February 13, 2007.

A graduate of Arvada High School, Chief Greer has been with the Fire District since 1979 as both an employee, where he worked his way up from Purchasing Agent to Assistant District Manager, and as a volunteer firefighter, where he spent time at Firefighter, Lieutenant, Captain, and Assistant Chief until he retired after twenty years of volunteer service. Greer has been the Deputy Chief since 1999. Chief Greer has attended Red Rocks Community College, Regis University, and the National Fire Academy.

Robb Roome, President of the Arvada Professional Fire Fighters Association IAFF Local #4056 said in a written statement that “Chief Greer has a proven track record of keeping the best interest of the City of Arvada and its citizens first, while maintaining a safe and dynamic workplace for the employees of the Fire District. We look forward to many years of a harmonious relationship with Chief Greer and the Arvada Fire Protection District.”
