## Two Alarm Fire at Weber Elementary

ARVADA – The Arvada Fire Protection District responded to a fire at Weber Elementary on Friday, June 01, 2007. The initial call to the 9-1-1 dispatch center came from the Jefferson County Schools Security office at 4:50 a.m. with a report of a fire alarm from multiple zones and multiple detectors in the school. Within three minutes, calls started coming in from neighbors reporting that smoke and fire could be seen from the building and a full first alarm assignment was given. (A first alarm assignment for the Arvada Fire Protection District is 4 Engines, 1 Ladder Truck and a Battalion Chief.) The first Engine arrived on scene at 4:56 a.m. and found fire and smoke coming from the roof of the structure. A second alarm assignment was given at 4:59 a.m. (A second alarm assignment is two additional Engines and one Ladder Truck.) The fire was declared under control at 5:34 a.m.

At this time, the fire is under investigation by the Arvada Fire Protection District's Fire Marshal's office and a cause will be released as soon as possible. Due to work that is involved in this process, it may take some time before a cause is determined.
