House Fire Sends One to Hospital

ARVADA –At 11:58 a.m. on July 25, 2011, Arvada fire fighters responded to reports of a house fire at 8884 W. 78th Place in Arvada. When fire fighters arrived, they found fire and smoke coming from the single-family residence. The sole resident of the home and his dog had escaped the house on their own. The unknown aged man was later transported by Pridemark Paramedics to Lutheran Hospital for possible smoke inhalation.

It took fire fighters 15 minutes to get the fire under control. The fire was declared out after approximately 30 minutes.

Fire fighters also had to fight the heat of the day during the fire. Because of that, all fire fighters on scene were medically assessed and cooled after fighting the fire.

At this time, the cause of the fire has not been determined.
