

**JUDGES' CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION RETURNS AND
STATEMENT OF BALLOTS**

**ARVADA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
JEFFERSON COUNTY, COLORADO**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED by the undersigned who conducted the election held in the Arvada Fire Protection District, Jefferson County, Colorado, on the 2nd day of November, 2010, that after qualifying by swearing and subscribing to their Oaths of Office, they opened the polls at 7:00 a.m., and that they kept the polls open continuously until the hour of 7:00 p.m. on said date, after which they counted the ballots cast for and against Ballot Issue 5A:

"SHALL ARVADA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$6,744,924 (FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR DOLLAR INCREASE) ANNUALLY BEGINNING IN LEVY YEAR 2010 (FOR COLLECTION IN CALENDAR YEAR 2011) BY INCREASING THE DISTRICT'S EXISTING TAX BY 5.23 MILLS TO BE USED FOR:

- AVOID THE CLOSURE OF ONE OR MORE FIRE STATIONS OR THE ROLLING CLOSURE OF FIRE STATIONS IN 2011 OR 2012.*
- ASSIST IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION (NFPA) 1710 REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SAFETY OF THE FIREFIGHTERS AND THE PUBLIC.*
- ALLOW FOR THE TIMELY REPLACEMENT OF FIRE TRUCKS AND OTHER DISTRICT ASSETS.*
- FUND FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS, ADMINISTRATION AND MAINTENANCE.*

*PROVIDED, THE DISTRICT'S TAX RATE SHALL NOT THEREAFTER BE INCREASED WITHOUT THE VOTERS' PRIOR APPROVAL; AND,
PROVIDED ALSO, THAT ALL REVENUE AND PROPERTY TAX REVENUE FROM THE 5.23 MILLS AND ANY EARNINGS ON THIS TAX, SHALL CONSTITUTE A PERMANENT VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHIN THE MEANING OF ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION AND AN EXCEPTION TO THE LIMITATIONS SET FORTH IN SECTION 29-1-301 OF THE COLORADO REVISED STATUTES AND ANY OTHER LAW?"*
