

Declaration of Temporary Fire Restrictions

The Arvada Fire Protection District hereby declares a fire ban effective on Tuesday, September 14, 2010 at 5 p.m. and shall remain in effect until superseded or repealed due to the High Fire Danger conditions within the boundaries of the Arvada Fire District. The following activities are prohibited.

1. Building, maintaining, or using any open fire or campfire unless the fire is contained within a permanently constructed fire grate in a developed area.
2. Building, maintaining, attending or using fire for the purpose of open burning of fence rows, ditches, debris or vegetation. (Burn permits issued and not executed prior to the effective date of this temporary fire ban shall not be authorized).
3. Smoking and the disposal of improperly extinguished smoking materials while on undeveloped public lands.
4. The use of fireworks or recreational rockets of any type.

The Fire Chief has the authority to issue this Temporary Fire Restriction under the International Fire Code 2006 edition and pursuant to County Resolution CC 97-433.
